USF IN FLORENCE PSYCHOLOGY & SOCIAL BEHAVIORAL SCIENCE SUMMER, 2019

OVERVIEW

USF has expanded its programming in Florence with a new program for our students in psychology, criminology, behavioral health care, and sociology disciplines. You will live in an apartment in central Florence with other USF students for six weeks taking courses that count toward your degree requirements taught by faculty from USF and our partner institution, Florence University of the Arts (FUA). In addition to these subjects, students may choose from a variety of disciplines that focus on the art, culture, food and history of Florence and Italy. The program includes a variety of course-based excursions to sites in and around Florence. Students must take at least 6 credits, and may take up to 9 credits for an additional cost. Students may also choose a one-week intensive Cultural Introduction Program for an additional 3 credits which takes students around many different parts of Italy.

COURSE INFORMATION

Abnormal Psychology; Forensic Psychology; Cross-Cultural Psychology; Addictions; Contemporary Mafia and Antimafia; Rape, Marriage and Legalized Crime, among many courses focusing on Italian culture, food, wine, art, history, etc.

- Pre-departure and on-site orientation

- Shared apartment accommodations

- Computer lab and library access
- Limited meal plan

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

STEP
1

Apply to and complete an application for an education abroad program. Have program questions? Visit Education Abroad's Gateway Office in MSC 3001.

Meet with your academic advisor to get your course approval form signed.

Once accepted, then commit to the program.
